WINNER Student Achievement Award!

This week our Junior Travel Ambassadors (JTAs) got to attend the TFL finals in the Oval, Kennington. It is a chance to recognise creativity, impact and

commitment to active travel by the 28 regional finalist schools. Our JTAs who went on the day were: Archie, Amalia, Maeve, Margaux and Emya. Our JTAs have spent the last 2 years encouraging children in our school to actively travel (ensuring we use our arms and legs rather than other forms of transport). They have created puppet shows on road safety for EYFS, climate change assemblies for KS1/KS2, ensured each year group has either scootering or cycling lessons, evidencing public transport use on school trips, creating surveys on transport usage and making competitions involving naming our well-known mascot Rosa the Hedgehog. The Student Achievement award category was all about seeing the progression of the children's confidence, leadership and teamwork. This category was chosen for them to enter after seeing all the progression these individuals have made over the last 2 years where they organise and plan events weekly with minimal supervision from Florie.


