Mary: A simple white/blue dress with a head scarf.

Joseph: Something brown/white. A scarf as a kind of belt works and a dishcloth as a head scarf.

Gabriel and other angels: All dressed in white if possible. Some angel wings and a halo are nice additions.

Narrators: Anything Christmassy! Christmas jumpers/bright colours welcome.

> Caesar Augustus: A white bedsheet with a coloured scarf over the top would work well.

> > Innkeepers, desert women + family members (mums, dads and children): Something similar to Joseph.

> > Royal subjects/roman soldiers: Similar to Herod (unless you have a roman costume already).

Shepherds: Similar to Joseph.

Wise men/kings: Bright colours and beards if possible!

Animals: Be creative! Paper plates, make-up & masks!
